

ETA of Kappa Alpha Theta was first established at Ann Arbor on December tenth, 1879. It was thought best, however, by the Grand Council, to withdraw the Charter, then given to the Chapter, in 1886.

The present Eta Chapter was established on July twenty-ninth, 1893, when the Charter was granted and the pledge given, to the twelve girls who had made application for the Chapter, by the representatives of the various Chapters, who were then assembled in Convention at Chicago, Ill.
