

TAU, of Kappa Alpha Theta, was established on September twenty-ninth, 1887, at the Northwestern University, Evanston, Illinois, with seven charter members. It was through the efforts of a member of Alpha that the Chapter was started here, and the pledge was given to these seven by her, and another delegate from Alpha.

The Chapter has always been a prosperous one in all respects. Its members have taken a high place socially, and, from the first, honors have been won by them. The original number of seven members has now been increased to fifty-two, from which two have been lost by death. The withdrawal of four members during the winter of 1894 has still further decreased Tau's membership, but they were felt to be uncongenial, and it seemed to be for the best.
