PSILON of Kappa Alpha Theta was established at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis, on February 6, 1889, with nine charter members, who were initiated by a delegate from Alpha.

At the time of the founding of the chapter there were already two fraternities established among the young women at the University, Kappa Kappa Gamma and Delta Gamma. The new chapter was kindly received by both the older ones, and the pleasant feeling then shown has always continued.
