

CHI of Kappa Alpha Theta was established on October tenth, 1889, at Syracuse University, Syracuse, New York, with twelve charter members, who were initiated by two delegates from Iota. A local society known as the Kappa Delta Phi had existed previous to this at the University, and it was to the members of this that the new Chapter was given.

The Chapter has always been a prosperous one, its members holding a high rank in scholarship, and a good social position.

At the last Convention of the fraternity, Chi was appointed to entertain her sisters at the next Convention, to be held in the Summer of 1895.
