Beta Gamma Chapter at Colorado State University was reinstalled on November 2, 2014, joining Chi Omega, Delta Delta Delta, Gamma Phi Beta, Kappa Delta, Kappa Kappa Gamma, Pi Beta Phi and Zeta Tau Alpha in the Panhellenic community. Colorado State is a public research institution in Fort Collins, Colorado.

Assisted by collegians from Beta Iota/Colorado and Beta Omega/Colorado College, nearly 100 collegians and two alumnae were initiated into Beta Gamma. Laura Ware Deorre, Delta Xi/North Carolina, Fraternity president, and Mary Jane Parker Beach, Beta Nu/Florida State, former Fraternity president and NPC delegate, presided over the Initiation Services. Additionally, 15 Fraternity officers and staff members participated in the ritual ceremonies and events. A group of 35 alumnae observed the Initiation Service.

Beta Gamma Chapter was first established at CSU in 1917, 38 years after the university opened. More than 2,000 women have been initiated into the chapter



since then. A new charter was signed by the new initiates and will hang alongside the original charter in the chapter's facility upon its opening in fall 2015.

Following the Charter Service, a celebratory brunch was held with more than 300 attendees from all over the country.
