HISTORIES of the EMORY UNIVERSITY SOCIAL CLUBS

INTERCLUB COUNCIL

The Interclub Council, the coordinating body of the Emory Women's Social Clubs, was founded in 1954. It has developed into a strong governing body through which the clubs can successfully discuss, organize and initiate functions and policies.

Each year the I. C. C. sponsors a Parents' Day Luncheon at the I. C. C. House, a Sadie Hawkins Race, and an Interclub Sing.

Its colors are royal purple and garnet red, symbolized in the purple violet and the red rose. It strives to foster cooperation and understanding among the clubs.

As the clubs become national sororities, so the I. C. C. will become a Panhellenic organization rooted in the Interclub Council tradition of strength through leadership, unity, and understanding.

ADELPHEAN SOCIETY

The Adelphean Society was organized on the Emory campus September 5, 1954. Their colors are blue and white; the flower is the violet.

As a service project they work in the charity ward of the Egleston Children's Hospital, and read to blind students. Annually they hold a Carnival for the Emory student body.

They are affiliated nationally with Alpha Delta Pi, which was

founded at Wesleyan College in Macon, Georgia. They were pledged to their national on February 8, 1959.

The number of charter members is 44.

ALPHA SIGMA DELTA CLUB

Alpha Sigma Delta was established at Emory November 6, 1953. Its symbol is the golden lyre; colors are scarlet and olive green.

Their service project has been the Cerebral Palsy School on Ponce de Leon. Each year they publish a Women's Student Directory.

They are affiliated nationally with Alpha Chi Omega, which was founded at DePauw University in Greencastle, Illinois. The date of National pledging was January 9, 1959.

The number of charter members is 44.

ANCHORA CLUB

The Anchora Club was established on the Emory campus September, 1954. Their colors are bronze, pink and blue; their flower is the cream colored rose.

Their service project is work with the Sight Conservation and Aid to the Blind at St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Atlanta.

This group is affiliated nationally with Delta Gamma Sorority, organized January 2, 1874. The girls were pledged to their national on February 7, 1959.

The number of charter members is 19.

DELTA CLUB

The Delta Club was organized on the Emory campus April 15, 1955. Their colors are yellow, gold and blue.

The service project of this group is visiting the Hillside Cottage Home for Underprivileged Children. Delta annually sponsors an Interfraternity-Inter-sorority Leadership Conference.

This group is a filiated nationally with Delta Delta Delta Sorority, organized Th of 1888 at Boston University. The girls were pledged nationally anary 8, 1959.

The number is 46.

DELTA SIGMA EPSILON CLUB

Delta Sigma Epsilon was organized November, 1954, at Emory. Their colors are red and grey.

This group does social work with the American Cancer Society in Atlanta.

The Delta Sigma Epsilon group is affiliated nationally with Alpha Epsilon Phi. Pledging to the national sorority was held January 11, 1959.

The number of charter members is 13.

FLEUR-DE-LIS CLUB

Fleur-de-lis was established on the Emory campus in October, 1954. Their colors are light and dark blue; their flower is the fleur-de-lis.

Their service project has been work with the Egleston Children's Hospital Charity ward. Each year they sponsor a "Wheel Whirl" dance for the Emory student body.

They are affiliated nationally with Kappa Kappa Gamma. This sorority was founded at Monmouth College, Monmouth, Illinois. Their date of pledging to Kappa was February 6, 1959.

The number of charter members is 45.

KITE CLUB

The Kite Club was organized on the Emory campus July 7, 1954. Their colors are black and gold and their flower is the pansy.

As a service project these girls work at the Junior League Speech School. They hold a Slave Auction annually to raise money for the March of Dimes drive.

This group is affiliated nationally with Kappa Alpha Theta Sorority, founded January 27, 1870, at DePauw University. The girls were pledged nationally January 11, 1959.

The number of charter members is 78.

PHILOMATHEAN CLUB

Philomathean was brought on the Emory campus in March, 1955. This group's colors are rose and white and their flower is the enchantress carnation.

The Philomathean social service project is a weekly visit to the children's Cerebral Palsy Home. They also have a Toy Cart at Egleston Hospital.

On January 6, 1959, this club was pledged to Phi Mu which was founded January 4, 1852, at Wesleyan College in Macon, Georgia.

The number of charter members is 26.

PI SIGMA CLUB

Pi Sigma was organized on the Emory campus September 15, 1954. Their colors are cardinal and straw, and their flower is the white carnation.

Their service project has been work with the DeKalb County Old People's Home. They also hold Study Habit Clinics annually for Emory students.

They are affiliated nationally with Chi Omega, founded at the University of Arkansas. Pi Sigma was pledged to its national February 22, 1959.

The number of charter members is 36.

TAU KAPPA DELTA CLUB

Tau Kappa Delta was founded at Emory in the summer of 1954. Their colors are olive green and white, and their flower is the white rose.

Their main service project is work with the Sheltering Arms Nursery. This year the TKD's gave a series of Sunday night suppers to raise money for charity.
