Eta Chi, Kappa Alpha Theta's 130th active college chapter, was installed December 2 at Boston University. Following the service, an installation reception was held in the beautiful Trustee Ballroom on campus; 220 people (including parents of the new initiates, Theta alumnae, and Boston University Panhellenic officers) attended.

Dale Robbins, assistant dean of students and director of judicial affairs, offered greetings from the University. Fraternity President Amy Hayner Kates, Alpha Phi/Tulane, presented a gift to the Panhellenic (a framed photo of all 26 NPC badges to hang in the student activities office), thanking them for their support during the establishment of the chapter. Not only was the current Panhellenic president on hand to accept the gift, but the past Panhellenic president, who graduated last spring, traveled from Colorado to

attend the celebration. The new chapter presented gifts to Madison Motley, Alpha Omicron/Oklahoma, and Elizabeth Mundy, Alpha Gamma/Ohio State, the educational leadership consultants (ELCs) who have been based with the chapter throughout the autumn.

On the day before the Charter Service, Kates initiated 116 members, including two legacies whose mothers were in attendance. Local alumnae hosted a post-initiation reception.

Theta joins eight National Panhellenic Conference groups—Alpha Delta Pi, Alpha Epsilon Phi, Alpha Phi, Delta Delta Delta, Delta Gamma, Gamma Phi Beta, Kappa Delta, and Sigma Kappa—on the BU campus.
